



Figure 1: Tanzania Marine Parks and Marine Reserves operating under the auspices of the Marine Parks and Reserves Unit.

A – TANGA & PEMBA CHANNEL

Tanga Yacht Club appears to be just outside of the Marine Park boarder and no one we know of has been asked for Park fees.

However, we were asked for fees in Pemba (as were many other visiting yachts). We were hit by a boat whist underway, causing damage to our hulls, claiming to be Marine Conservation in Pemba. They were asking for \$200 US dollars cash, and we therefore left Pemba altogether.




Entry fee is \$3 USD for Marine Parks (MBCA, TUMCA, CHABAMCA and MIMCA)

Entry fee is \$5 USD in Unguja/Zanzibar Island and PECCA in Pemba Island

*Note: Entry fees for special area within Mnemba is \$25 USD.

*Anchoring within a Marine Park is \$20 USD/ per day.





Figure 1. Map of Dar es Salaam coast showing the DMRs study sites.
